- Six fully furnished Black Forest farm houses and one labourer's cottage
- The 600-year-old "Little Castle from Effringen" is one of the oldest buildings in a German open-air museum
- The "Hermann Schilli" house (built in 1980) with its modern lecture room and a permanent exhibition on the lifestyle of the 1980s
- A number of outbuildings including storage houses, chapels, grain and sawmills as well as boundary stones and wayside shrines
- Typical gardens and traditional livestock (e.g. horses, cows, pigs and goats)
- Experience the inner workings of mills, different trades and crafts, a workshop for families as well as other exciting activities
- A wide range of tours for groups, school and kindergarten children
